

## Replace Plugin Crashing Gigperformer

Hello,  
I am running Sonoma 14.1.1 on an M1 Max. I have been updating my rackspace with a larger mixer to add the streaming audio file player. However, when I do this Gigperformer crashes. The only work around I found is to load the larger mixer, rewire, label the channel and set the levels then delete the one I am replacing. Just wanted you to be aware.

Below is the specific thread and you can see that Kontakt 7 is at the top and therefore the cause of the crash.  
You could forward to NI but my sense is that Kontakt 7 is quite buggy — I'm personally sticking with Kontakt 6 for anything serious right now.
